

Wednesday Prayer Priority for November 2025

November 5, 2025

Today we are praying for the Persecuted Church.

2 Thessalonians 3:1-3 As for other matters, brothers and sisters, pray for us that the message of the Lord may spread rapidly and be honored, just as it was with you. ² And pray that we may be delivered from wicked and evil people, for not everyone has faith. ³ But the Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen you and protect you from the evil one.

Romans 15:30-33 I urge you, brothers and sisters, by our Lord Jesus Christ and by the love of the Spirit, to join me in my struggle by praying to God for me. ³¹ Pray that I may be kept safe from the unbelievers in Judea and that the contribution I take to Jerusalem may be favorably received by the Lord's people there, ³² so that I may come to you with joy, by God's will, and in your company be refreshed. ³³ The God of peace be with you all. Amen.

10 Ways to Pray for the Persecuted Church

1. Pray they will sense God's presence.

Hebrews 13:5 God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."

2. Pray they will experience God's comfort.

2 Thessalonians 2:16-17 May our Lord Jesus Christ himself and God our Father, who loved us and by his grace gave us eternal encouragement and good hope, ¹⁷ encourage your hearts and strengthen you in every good deed and word.

3. Pray they will see God open doors to evangelism.

Colossians 4:3 And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains.

4. Pray they will continue to boldly share the Gospel.

Acts 4:29 Now, Lord, consider their threats and enable your servants to speak your word with great boldness.

5. Pray they will forgive and love their persecutors.

Matthew 5:44, 45 But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you ⁴⁵ that you may be children of your Father in heaven.

6. Pray they will know we are praying for them.

2 Timothy 1:3 I thank God, whom I serve, as my ancestors did, with a clear conscience, as night and day I constantly remember you in my prayers.

7. Pray they will be granted wisdom in covert ministry work.

Acts 9:23-25 After many days had gone by, there was a conspiracy among the Jews to kill him, ²⁴ but Saul learned of their plan. Day and night they kept close watch on the city gates in order to kill him. ²⁵ But his followers took him by night and lowered him in a basket through an opening in the wall.

8. Pray they will remain joyful amid suffering.

Acts 5:41 The apostles left the Sanhedrin, rejoicing because they had been counted worthy of suffering disgrace for the Name.

9. Pray they will mature in their faith.

Colossians 1:28-29 He is the one we proclaim, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone fully mature in Christ.

²⁹ To this end I strenuously contend with all the energy Christ so powerfully works in me.

10. Pray they will be rooted in God's Word.

2 Timothy 3:16-17 All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, ¹⁷ so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

November 12, 2025

Praying for World Missions: The Missionary Family

- Pray for new missionaries on the field as they adjust to being away from family, friends, and things familiar.
- Pray for missionary children and youth, that they will adjust to the various cultures and feel at home.
- Pray for missionary kids who return to the U. S. after high school graduation and have to stay (often without family) to begin their college education or vocation.
- Pray for missionary parents who have to leave their college-age children in the States alone and return to the field without them (especially those parents who enter the "empty nest" stage).
- Pray for strength and comfort for missionaries whose family members (especially parents, grandparents, and siblings) have suffered serious illnesses and tragedies.
- Pray for the comfort of the Holy Spirit upon missionaries who lose loved ones while far away from home.
- Pray for missionaries as they minister in evangelism, church planting, training of national leaders, and compassion ministries. Ask the Lord to empower them as they face the challenges of ministering cross-culturally.

November 19, 2025

Today we are praying for World Missions.

- **Pray that our hearts would come into alignment with God's heart for the lost.**

2 Peter 3:9 The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. Instead he is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.

- **Pray that we would live missional lives in the way we pray, give, and go.**

Matthew 28:18-19 ¹⁸ Then Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

- **Pray that our church would be a part of supporting laborers to go and take the gospel to the places that are unreached.**
- **Pray that we would individually welcome the nations that are at our doorstep with the love of Christ as a witness to them.**

November 26, 2025

Today we are praying for World Missions.

- **Pray that the gospel of our Lord would reach the ends of the Earth and that those who haven't heard would have a chance to hear.**
Matthew 24:14 And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.
- **Pray that laborers would rise up and go into the harvest.**
Matthew 9:37-38 Then he said to his disciples, “The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. ³⁸ Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.”
- **Pray that lost people would begin to have dreams and visions of their resurrected Savior that would cause them to seek God.**
- **Pray that our lives would be lived missionally as we represent Christ to the watching world around us!**

December 3, 2025

This week we are praying for our Giving Tree Outreach.

1. We ask God to use this tangible expression of love as a doorway to the presentation of the Good News of Jesus Christ.
2. We ask God's provision for every donation, resource, and gift given to meet every need presented to our church.
3. We ask God to encourage children of families who are unemployed, dealing with prolonged or terminal illness, and those whose parents are incarcerated.
4. We ask God for peace, protection, healing, and grace to cover our community and especially for families who are struggling financially, physically, and emotionally.

5. We ask God for strength for our volunteers and workers who organize and distribute gifts, and for those who show the love of Christ to families in need this Christmas.
6. We ask God to energize our church to take this project on and work together as individuals and families to see the needs of others met through our generosity.
