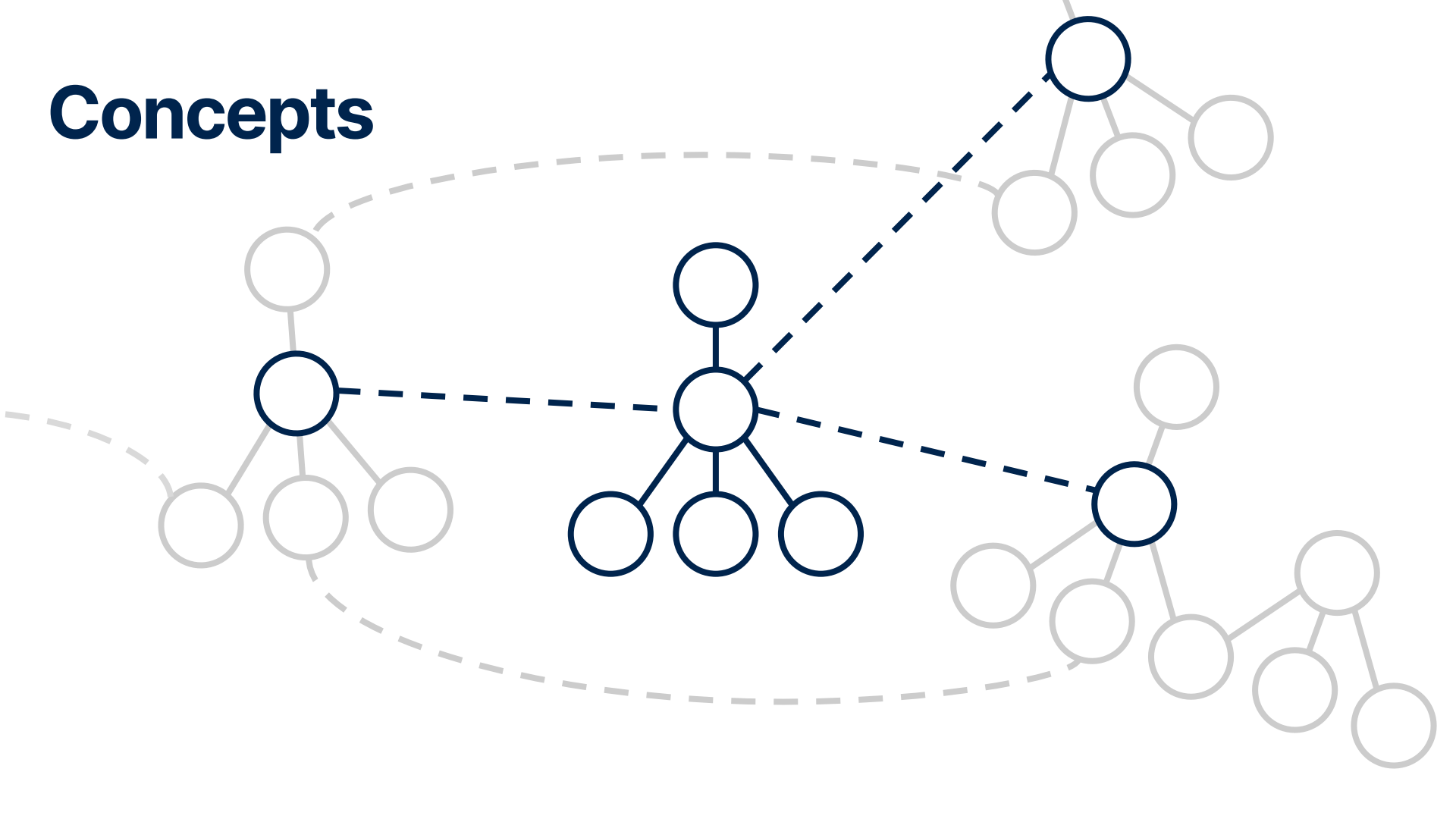
The Drainage and Flood Control Ordinance of 1960 makes provisions for the management of drainage authorities for the areas listed in Annex 1. The Ordinance consists of 6 articles, divided into 6 Chapters: Preliminary (1), Authority Members (2), Authority Committees (4), employees (5) and Various Orders (6). Note: As the previous Ordinance was repealed, the provisions of the previous Ordinance are no longer in force.

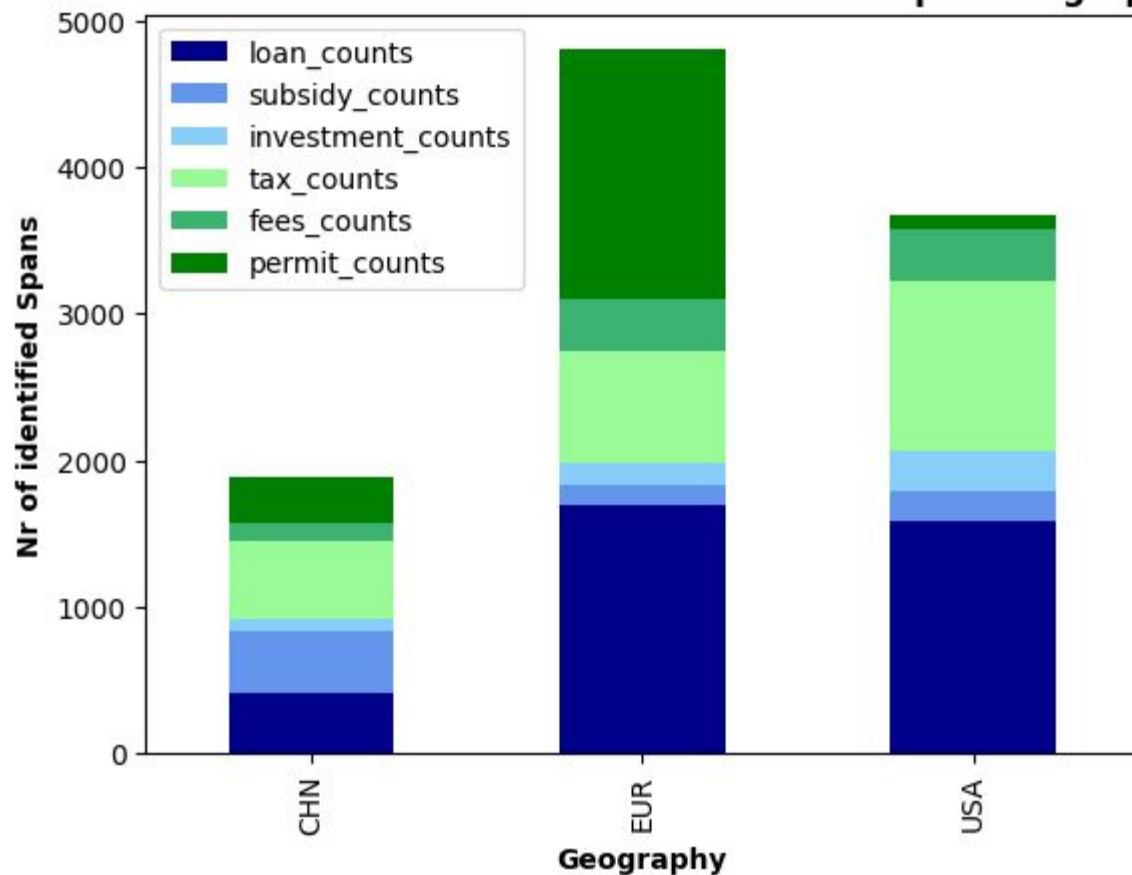

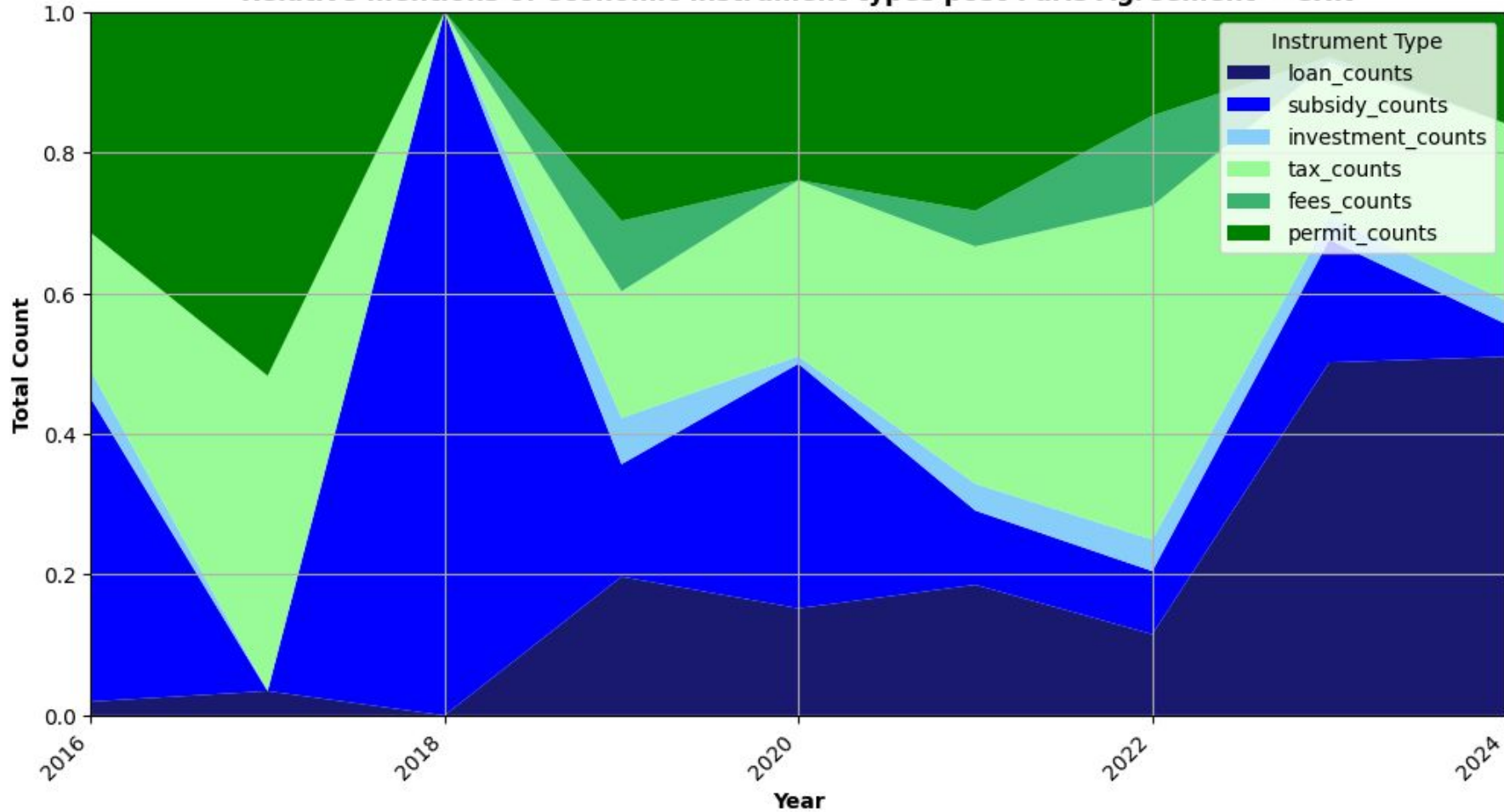




Loans and Subsidies versus Taxes and Fees per Geography
