#### Barcodes on the Account Management Excel Export

The export from the Accounts grid has been updated to use the Code 39 barcode font by default for barcode columns.

**Please note:** You must have the Code 39 barcode font installed on your computer to display these as scannable barcodes. They will otherwise show as follows: \*12345678\*

## Internal Vendor Contract Updates

To better support the setup process for internal vendors, a few additions have been made to the Contract configuration. The **Delivery Groups** now include an **Unassigned** group to which sites can be assigned. The Unassigned group allows sites to be entirely excluded from placing orders to the internal vendor. Any sites in the Unassigned group will be excluded from the Shipping Schedule and Ordering Conditions to simplify the contract configuration process further.

On the **Shipping Group** side of the contract configuration, the **Default** group has been similarly enhanced. The system will now consider the presence of a shipping schedule as an indication of whether the Default group is being used. If no schedule is present, the system will highlight any items associated with the Default group and provide a warning, encouraging users to either set a schedule for the Default group or assign those items to a different shipping group.

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


#### • Distribution Quantities Report

The Quantities Report has been added to the Distribution tool. This super report allows users to generate different combinations of item quantities for review and comparison. By default, the Custom report format is selected, allowing users to choose which columns to include in the report. Up to 3 columns can be selected, including a 'Discrepancy' column to show the difference between two quantity values. The Picking Variance and Sent vs. Received report formats will simply select the columns on behalf of the user, as these are pre-configured reports.

Beyond these parameters, the report also includes an option to either sum up the quantities across all site orders or to separate each order into its own report page. Lastly, the report has an option to group items by Item Category to separate items for report readability.
