




Day 3, July 11: Zurich


Day 6, July 14: Lucerne - Zermatt

After lunch at a local restaurant, the afternoon and evening are free to spend in Zermatt. The adventurous among us could try a hike on one of

the many surrounding trails. Or, take a stroll through the romantic town streets to discover why Zermatt boasts one of the most charming apres-ski scenes in all of Europe.

Day 8, July 16: Zermatt - Geneva





Post-Tour Program Itinerary

Friday July 17

For those joining our exclusive post-tour program to Verona and Venice, a morning flight from Geneva to Verona via Munich will be arranged. We'll touch down in Verona at lunchtime, and immediately head to the famous Masi winery for lunch and a special tasting. Masi was founded on the idea that wine should be more than an accompaniment to food. Here, the wine and cuisine are paired in perfect harmony, with each complimenting the other to create an entirely unique experience. Later this afternoon, we'll check in to the 5-star Hotel Due Torri in Verona's historic center. Once settled in our elegant accommodation, we'll enjoy cocktails on the hotel's East Terrace, before proceeding to a spirited dinner at a local trattoria.

Saturday July 18

Our morning sightseeing tour takes us through the bustling Piazza delle Erbe, once the Roman forum and now home to a lively market. We'll also see the imposing 12th century Torre dei Lamberti, and of course, the balcony where Juliet is said to have uttered her famous question. Enjoy a special lunch in a historic landmark restaurant after the morning tour. The afternoon will be free to continue sightseeing on your own, or you can rest and prepare for the spellbinding evening ahead. Tonight, we'll have premium tickets to one of the most beloved Italian operas, "Nabucco" in the famous Arena di Verona. Sunday July 19




Monday July 20

We will also visit Torcello, the first settlement in the Venetian lagoon, to visit the 12th century cathedral of Santa Maria Assunta, one of the most ancient religious edifices in the Veneto containing the earliest Byzantine mosaics in the area of Venice. Lunch will be served at the world-famous Locanda Cipriani, one of Hemingway's favorite hideaways. Return to Venice for a free afternoon. Tonight, gather with your fellow travelers for one last dinner together at the hotel's gourmet restaurant overlooking the Grand Canal.


