**RESOLUTION NO. 19-2020/21**

**ORDINANCE NO. 29-2020/21**

**A. HOWE SPRINGS FIRE DEPARTMENT/PROCUREMENT**

**1. LADDER TRUCK**

Council Is Asked To Authorize The Use Of The Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) Cooperative Purchasing Program For The Purchase Of One (1) E-One Typhoon Aerial Ladder Truck And The Necessary Equipment From Allsource Enterprises, LLC dba Safe Industries For The Howe Springs Fire Department As Funded By Capital Project Sales Tax III. Two Options Are Offered:

Option A (Prepayment Option): In An Amount Not To Exceed \$900,000; 100% Of The Cost Of The Truck Must Be Paid Within 15 Days Of Contract Execution Which Is To Take Place No Later Than April 30, 2021.

Option B (Non-Prepayment Option): In An Amount Not To Exceed \$920,318.

(Howe Springs Fire Department Chief Billy Dillon recommends the purchase under Option A.)

**2. PUMPERS**

Council Is Asked To Authorize The Use Of The Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) Cooperative Purchasing Program For Purchase Of Two (2) E-One Typhoon Pumpers And The Necessary Equipment From Allsource Enterprises, LLC dba Safe Industries For The Howe Springs Fire Department As Funded By Capital Project Sales Tax III. Two Options Are Offered:

Option A (Prepayment Option): In An Amount Not To Exceed \$1,200,000; 100% Of The Cost Of The Truck Must Be Paid Within 15 Days Of Contract Execution Which Is To Take Place No Later Than April 30, 2021.

Option B (Non-Prepayment Option): In An Amount Not To Exceed \$1,227,091.

(Howe Springs Fire Department Chief Billy Dillon recommends the purchase under Option A.)

**3. RESCUE VEHICLE**

Council Is Asked To Authorize The Use Of The Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) Cooperative Purchasing Program For The Purchase Of One (1) E-One Typhoon Rescue And The Necessary Equipment From Allsource Enterprises, LLC dba Safe Industries For The Howe Springs Fire Department As Funded By Capital Project Sales Tax III. Two Options Are Offered:

Option A (Prepayment Option): In An Amount Not To Exceed \$561,100; 100% Of The Cost Of The Truck Must Be Paid Within 15 Days Of Contract Execution Which Is To Take Place No Later Than April 30, 2021.

Option B (Non-Prepayment Option): In An Amount Not To Exceed \$574,800.

(Howe Springs Fire Department Chief Billy Dillon recommends the purchase under Option A.)

**B. JOHNSONVILLE FIRE DEPARTMENT/PROCUREMENT**

**1. LADDER TRUCK**

Council Is Asked To Authorize The Sole Source Purchase Of One (1) Cobra Aerial Ladder Truck From Rosenbauer South Dakota, LLC For Johnsonville Fire Department To Be Funded From Capital Project Sales Tax III Funds. Two Options Are Offered:

Option A (Prepayment Option): In An Amount Not To Exceed \$894,000; 100% Of The Cost Of The Truck Must Be Paid Up-Front.

Option B (Non-Prepayment Option): In An Amount Not To Exceed \$899,053.

(Johnsonville Fire Department Chief Henry Humphries recommends the purchase under Option A.)

**2. RESCUE TRUCK**

Council Is Asked To Authorize The Use Of The Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) Cooperative Purchasing Program To Purchase One (1) M2 Freightliner Rescue Truck And The Necessary Equipment From Rosenbauer South Dakota, LLC For The Johnsonville Fire Department As Funded By Capital Project Sales Tax III. Two Options Are Offered:

Option A (Prepayment Option): In An Amount Not To Exceed \$379,924; 100% Of The Cost Of The Truck Must Be Paid Up-Front.

Option B (Non-Prepayment Option): In An Amount Not To Exceed \$387,804.

(Johnsonville Fire Department Chief Henry Humphries recommends the purchase under Option A.)

**C. OLANTA FIRE DEPARTMENT/PROCUREMENT**

**PUMPER**

Council Is Asked To Authorize The Use Of The Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) Cooperative Purchasing Program For The Purchase Of One (1) Commander Pumper And The Necessary Equipment From Rosenbauer South Dakota, LLC For The Olanta Fire Department As Funded By Capital Project Sales Tax III. Two Options Are Offered:

Option A (Prepayment Option): In An Amount Not To Exceed \$566,043; 100% Of The Cost Of The Truck Must Be Paid Up-Front.

Option B (Non-Prepayment Option): In An Amount Not To Exceed \$578,755.

(Olanta Fire Department Chief Jimmy Coker recommends the purchase under Option A.)

**D. WEST FLORENCE FIRE DEPARTMENT/PROCUREMENT**

**PUMPERS**

Council Is Asked To Authorize The Use Of The Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) Cooperative Purchasing Program For The Purchase Of Two (2) KME Panther Fire Pumpers And The Necessary Equipment From Allsource Enterprises, LLC dba Safe Industries For The West Florence Fire Department As Funded By Capital Project Sales Tax III. Two Options Are Offered:

Option A (Prepayment Option): In An Amount Not To Exceed \$1,138,800; 100% Of The Cost Of The Truck Must Be Paid Within 15 Days Of Contract Execution Which Is To Take Place No Later Than April 30, 2021.

Option B (Non-Prepayment Option): In An Amount Not To Exceed \$1,164,143.

(West Florence Fire Department Chief Howard Worrell recommends the purchase under Option A.)
