L through M press	4	W through Zpress	9

If your name is called and you are not in court, a Bench Warrant will be issued for your arrest.

If your case is not disposed of during regular General Sessions Court, you must appear for the next term of court, <u>and</u> each term thereafter until your case is resolved. If you do not know when Court starts again, please call our office at (843) 423-3303.
