

Appearances Before Florence County Board of Voter Registration & Elections

Request to be Heard

Should any person, group, or organization request to be heard upon any matter at a regular or special meeting of the Board of Voter Registration & Elections, such person, group, or organization shall submit a written request to the Chair of the Board of Registration & Elections to place such matter on the agenda for the meeting at least thirteen (7) days prior to the date set for such meeting. The request shall specifically state the reason for the appearance and contact information so that the Chairman may let the person, group, or organization know the status of such request.

Any person, group or organization, when about to speak, shall address himself to the Chair. And, in speaking, shall avoid disrespect of the County or any member of the Board or any employee of Voter Registration & Elections. The speaker shall confine themselves to the topic of the request to appear.

Matters Not Within the Board of Registration & Elections Jurisdiction

No matter shall be entered on the agenda or heard by the Board unless it is within the Board's authority or jurisdiction.

Appearances Before the Board are limited to three (3) to five (5) minutes.
