



DOG BED

Make this bed with 1×6 clear maple lumber. Using a miter saw, miter-cut four 25½×25¼-inch pieces for frame sides. Glue and join frame using finish nails. Measure the frame opening, then cut a ¾-inch piece of plywood to fit snugly to measure about 24×24 inches. Hold bottom in place with finish nails, hammered through sides. Attach purchased tapered-wood feet. Paint and let dry. Cut 4-inch-depth cushion foam to fit, about 24×24 inches. Make a slipcover for the foam using sturdy fabric. Assemble for your pup's bedtime.
