




1. *Jesus' Triumphal Entry*



4. *The Last Supper*

5. Jesus Washes the Disciples' Feet

6. Jesus Prays in the Garden of Gethsemane

"Again, for the second time, he went away and prayed, 'My Father, if this cannot pass unless I drink it, your will be done.'"



"Then Pilate took Jesus and flogged him."





soldier; also his tunic. But the tunic

11. *Soldiers Pierce Jesus with a Spear*

"But one of the soldiers pierced

came out blood and water."



of the Jews."


