We embrace higher density across the city in line with our natural landscape without losing our unique character. We become more resilient to climate events and prove that Pittsburgh can grow and change without sacrificing quality of life or our identity.

People choose from our 90 neighborhoods. drawn by different types of old and new housing they can afford, confident they can stay over time as their needs change.

Race or income no longer predetermine where we live and neighborhoods buzz with diverse populations that are reflected in the local businesses and welcoming public spaces.

We attract development and thoughtfully transform long-overlooked areas for the people who live there and care for vacant buildings and land until they are given new life.

We choose a future where cars don't have to be the most convenient way to get around, and options for public transit, walking, or rolling are safe, easy, affordable, sustainable, and reliable from first mile to last

People enjoy exploring and navigating the city using our tree-lined streets, unique city steps, robust bike network, beautifully maintained

We lean into our incredible natural surroundings. becoming a post-industrial model for creative and effective climate adaptation and a safe haven for climate migrants.

Restored hills, valleys, rivers, and trees act as natural defenses against flooding, landslides, and more extreme weather, and give us cleaner air and water

Our hilly, water-rich landscape dictates where and how we develop; we avoid high-risk areas, tear down where we need to, and support neighbors as they move to safer ground.

We are more aware of and connected to our environment, using our rivers and greenways through every season and adapting public spaces and parks to help manage stormwater and climate challenges.

Bold blue-green infrastructure and clean energy solutions help lower household costs and bring environmental benefits to every neighborhood, especially those historically burdened by pollution.
