For about 12 of those years, he used Telerik components, but with the latest price increase, he couldn't justify the expense any longer for the features it delivered.

Solution

Jan's search for an affordable solution led him to Syncfusion Essential Studio. In addition to its price point, he was impressed by the breadth of components and features for the .NET MAUI, ASP.NET MVC, Blazor, and Windows Forms platforms.

Results

With Syncfusion integrated into his development toolkit, his projects are nicer and a little faster. The UI is friendly, the components were easy to integrate, and, most importantly for his clientele, the components can be deployed to mobile, web, and desktop environments.
