Challenges

Mansour and the RenDter team were in the process of making an internal data-driven application that tracks information about notifications, from the assigned agent to the cost associated with the solution. At first, Mansour was using DevExtreme and jQWidgets, but he wanted something that didn't require a mix of Java and .NET, so he went looking for an alternative. That was when he found Syncfusion Essential Studio.

Solution

To be able to include all the functionality he wanted in the application, Mansour needed a more comprehensive solution. He happened upon the DocumentEditor component, which allowed him to work in a browser by using templates and placeholders. Another component he took to using was the dynamic Grid, which allowed for filtering and more interactivity with data.
