Retain and Expand Existing Businesses

Manufacturer Invests in Future - Fond du Lac, Wis.

Mid-States Aluminum Corp.'s investment in energy efficiency included a production renovation that is paying off now and will keep providing energy and cost savings for years to come. The manufacturer's efficiency upgrades earned it more than \$324,000 in Focus on Energy incentives.

Maintain and Improve Infrastructure and Affordability

County Seeks to Improve Employee Comfort - Juneau, Wis.

The Henry Dodge Office Building's chiller was inefficient and nearing the end of its life. By installing a new, high efficiency air cooled chiller, Dodge County employees' comfort level has improved and earned the County more than \$28,000 in incentives in Focus on Energy incentives.

Promote Sustainability

Mount Horeb Area Historical Society - Mount Horeb, Wis.

The Mount Horeb Area Historical Society made sustainability a priority when it expanded its facility. The Historical Society received a total incentive of more than \$14,000 from Focus on Energy for implementing energy-saving measures, and will save more than \$9,000 a year in reduced energy costs.

Preserve Cultural Identity

Mule-Hide Manufacturing - Cornell, Wis.

In 2019 and 2020 with the assistance of Focus on Energy's Rural Industrial Bonus offering, Mule-Hide installed VFDs on pumps, high efficiency re-pulper rotors, completed compressed air projects, LED lighting projects, and insulation projects. These projects will save them 1,459,000 kWh, 15,741 therms, and \$111,3000 annually.

Support New Development

Redevelopment of Landmark - Madison, Wis.

Seeing Garver Feed Mill today, it's hard to imagine the dilapidated state it lay in just a few years ago. Baum Revision Real Estate Development took the east Madison landmark from disrepair to desirable location. The energy-saving features built into the redeveloped building earned nearly \$19,000 in Focus on Energy incentives.

Nurture Innovation and Technology

Baker Manufacturing Invests in Innovation - Evansville, WI

Staying ahead of the game, Baker Manufacturing invested in new melting technology that will better manage the melting process and reduce energy usage at the facility. The new equipment, assisted nearly \$160,000 in incentives from Focus on Energy, will save enough to power almost 200 homes for 15 years.
