
How to Participate

Finalize your energy efficiency projects and submit the required paperwork as directed in the enrollment letter. The bonus will automatically be added to your incentive.

Eligibility Requirements

- Available to school and government customers only.
- Eligible for custom and prescriptive planned capital projects.
- Assessments, tune-ups, and new construction projects are ineligible.
- Projects are eligible for a bonus if the workbook is submitted/updated prior to purchase of equipment.
- If you completed a workbook in 2022, contact your Energy Advisor to update it for 2023.
