Apply for Financial Rebates

Enhanced Project Planning Bonus - Meet with your Energy Advisor to identify future energy-saving priorities and strategic energy goals. Participating tribal nation-owned entities will receive a 50% bonus up to \$10,000 in bonus rebates per customer.

<u>Prescriptive and Custom Rebates</u> - Reduce your energy efficiency project's overall cost by applying for financial funding. Work with your Energy Advisor to determine if your project needs pre-approval.

Identify a Project

Project Assessment Incentive - Need help determining the viability of a potential energy project for complex or process-related equipment? Focus on Energy covers 50% of the external cost, up to \$15,000, for studying and developing an energy savings project.

<u>Solar PV Rebates</u> - Looking to go solar? Businesses are eligible for up to \$50,000 in rebates. Funding for other renewable projects are also available. Contact your <u>Energy Advisor</u> for more information.

Operations and Maintenance - Enjoy the benefits of an efficient building by keeping your equipment tuned-up or completing a comprehensive review of your building's operations.

Make an Energy Plan

<u>Tribal Nation Energy Plan</u> - Identify energysaving goals and create a community energy plan to achieve them. Focus on Energy offers up to \$15,000 for plan development utilizing an external vendor or internal labor. Maximum rebate request is capped at 100% of the plan cost and can be combined with federal funding.

Residential Offerings

In 2023 Focus on Energy is providing rebates to make your residential and multifamily properties more energy efficient. These offerings are unique and exclusively offered to tribal nations at higher rates than the standard rebates provided annually to qualified building owners in Wisconsin.

Check out the list below for approved equipment upgrades and funding opportunities.

Smart Thermostats

- · Natural gas/heat pumps LP does not qualify.
- · Smart thermostats for eligible housing.
- Limited to 80% of the project cost, up to \$150.

Single Family - HVAC

- Homes heated with natural gas
 - 80% of the cost of a furnace/boiler, up to \$4,000.
- Homes heated with LP, oil, wood, and electric heat - Ducted or ductless heat pump installation includes 80% of project cost, up to \$8,000.

Single Family - Insulation & Air Sealing

- · Natural gas or electric heat only.
- Limited to 80% of the project costs, up to \$4,000.

Multifamily - Insulation & Air Sealing

- · Natural gas or electric heat only.
- \$1/ft² of attic space, \$0.80/ft² of wall space.

Multifamily - HVAC

- Includes LP, oil, wood, and electric heat.
- Ducted or ductless heat pump, up to \$800.
- Ducted or ductless cold climate heat pump, up to \$1,000.

Multifamily - HVAC

- · Includes natural gas.
- Ducted or ductless heat pump, up to \$2,000.
- Ducted or ductless cold climate heat pump, up to \$2,600.

BPI Training and Equipment

 Includes all equipment costs per Tribal Community unless the equipment was provided in 2022.

Rebates amounts are capped, and all projects must be pre-approved by Focus on Energy and a designated representation from the Tribal Community. Projects must be completed and applications submitted within 60 days.
