Media Guidelines

Press Registration

Complimentary press credentials are issued only to qualified journalists (reporters, editors, freelance writers, bloggers and news photographers, producers, etc.) working for media outlets relevant to ESOPs. The ESOP Association (TEA) reserves the right to deny requests for media attendance at any TEA event. All press must be registered for the TEA event they wish to attend and must comply with any ground rules set by TEA.

Embargo Policy

Any information being presented at the TEA event is embargoed until the time of the presentation.

Press Room - If Available

Only individuals who are registered as press may access any press room or attend any press events. If you are a member of the press and have not registered for the TEA event you wish to attend, please contact TEA's Public Affairs Department to be credentialed appropriately.

Press Conferences

Media events or news briefings other than those organized by TEA are not permitted during the TEA event being attended.

No On-Site Soliciting

All press registrants require appropriate credentials and are subject to prior approval by TEA.

Working press with complimentary credentials may not solicit business from exhibitors, spokespeople or attendees during TEA events. Prohibited activities include, but are not limited to, marketing and sales of satellite tours for or by on-air talent, producers and/or production staff, and marketing and sales of ad space for any publication of any kind by reporters, editors and/or photographers. Anyone found engaging in such behavior will be subject to having their working press credentials revoked immediately. TEA reserves the right to enforce the rules and policies as deemed appropriate. Enforcement of these rules and policies may result in the ejection from the premises of any persons lacking the appropriate credentials and/or registration.

Media Requests

On request, TEA provides a list of the registered media outlets. Please contact TEA's Public Affairs Department to obtain the list. TEA does not share the individual contact information of registered members of the press.

Employees or contractors of television, radio, or newspaper ESOPs or their affiliated organizations are welcome to attend the conference, but not as a member of the press unless explicitly approved by TEA.
