

UDIA NSW ROY SHEARGOLD SCHOLARSHIP 2020 ENTRY GUIDELINES



INTRODUCTION

The Roy Sheargold Scholarship was founded in memory of one of the most respected figures in the property development sector, life member of UDIA National and NSW, Roy Sheargold. Roy sat on the Council of the Urban Development Institute of Australia (NSW) almost 50 years ago. He remained actively involved in the industry, UDIA and international industry bodies for more than 45 years. Roy believed that if you wanted to be a great developer you had to continually update your knowledge and travel the world to learn from international developers.

AWARD OVERVIEW

The UDIA NSW Roy Sheargold Scholarship is awarded annually to an individual who demonstrates exceptional professional and/or academic achievement. They would have leadership qualities, an ability to inspire others and aspirations to achieve and perform at the highest level. Ultimately this award is about supporting our industry's aspiring leaders and helping individuals get to the next level. For this reason the ideal applicant would use the scholarship to conduct research, further their education and/or professional networks. The successful applicant will be required to complete an acquittal report within 12 months of receiving the scholarship, once the scholarship activity has been undertaken.

SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT BENEFITS

The successful applicant for the 2020 Roy Sheargold Scholarship will receive financial assistance of up to \$7,500. Additional benefits include exposure to the industry, a featured article in the UDIA NSW Urban Icon Magazine, opportunities to present at UDIA NSW events and engagement with UDIA NSW committees. The RSS Committee reserve the right to review the amount of financial assistance offered if deemed necessary.

HOW TO ENTER

Applicants can be self-nominated or nominated by a third party. To enter, complete the two minute online nomination form which asks for the details of the applicant. The applicant will then be emailed an official application form which they will need to complete and return via email to Caitlyn Douglas with their CV and headshot by Friday 24 July 2020.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be eligible to enter, applicants must:

- Be a member of the UDIA NSW
- Currently be working in the property development industry or studying property or related fields
- Be based in New South Wales

JUDGING PROCESS

The RSS Committee will assess all applications and determine the 2020 Roy Sheargold Scholarship recipient. The winner will be announced at the Presidents Luncheon, September 2020 (date to be confirmed).
