There are few online learning programs in the District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS), the district encompassing Washington, DC. The DC school district provides technology infrastructure and teacher training to support and encourage [blended learning](#), the combination of face-to-face instruction with digital content and technology integration.

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While the district does not offer supplemental online classes to its students, many high schools offer core classes in a blended format, primarily to be taken as credit recovery. The curriculum is delivered online, but students may be required to meet with the teacher or attend a class period one or two times a week. There is one charter school online program, [Friendship PCS Online](#), that enrolls DC students in grades K-8 in a hybrid format.
