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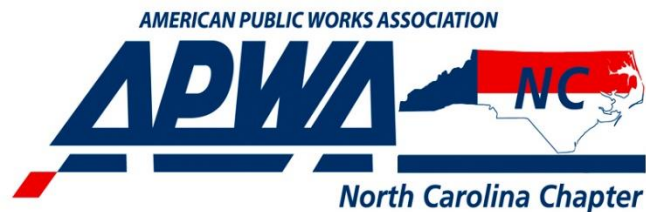

We would like to invite you to partner with us at the 2026 **APWA-North Carolina Combined Equipment Services and Streets Division Annual Conference**. This year's conference will be held October 28–30, 2026, at the **Harrah's Cherokee Hotel & Convention Center** in Cherokee, North Carolina. Online registration will start July 1, 2026; however, we are currently accepting mailed registrations.

This is an excellent opportunity for you to highlight your company's products and services to Public Works professionals from across North Carolina. We have developed an engaging program packed with professional development hours, networking opportunities, and fun activities. Also included is the Partner Registration Form, along with detailed information about the event and partnership opportunities. All Partners will receive special recognition during the conference, so please be sure to provide the appropriate information when registering. **The deadline for Partner registration is October 9, 2026.** A \$100 late fee will apply to registrations received after that date. Exhibit space is available on a first-come, first-served basis, and additional registrations cannot be accepted once all spaces are filled. We strongly encourage early registration.

New for 2026, we have simplified our Partner registration structure to provide greater flexibility for exhibitors. Partnership levels continue to include the same registration and recognition benefits; however, companies displaying equipment may now choose from three Equipment Display options based on the size of their display. This new format allows partners to select the partnership level that best fits their organization and then add the appropriate equipment display option, if needed. We hope this streamlined approach makes the registration process easier to understand and provides greater flexibility for showcasing equipment.

Electrical service is available at no additional charge when requested on the registration form. Same-day electrical requests must be coordinated and paid directly through the Harrah's Cherokee Hotel & Convention Center.

Important: Equipment or vehicles displayed inside the convention center must have **no more than 1/8 tank of fuel**. Please do not refuel prior to entering the building.

Equipment Display Upgrade (Optional)

Companies displaying vehicles or equipment may select one of the following display packages based on the space required.

Tier	Price	Display Space
Tier 1 – Basic	\$2,000	Up to 400 sq. ft. (10' x 40')
Tier 2 – Standard	\$4,000	Up to 600 sq. ft. (20' x 30' or 10' x 60')
Tier 3 – Expanded	\$5,250	Up to 800 sq. ft. (Flexible layout)

Additional conference registrations may be purchased for \$250 per person beyond those included with your selected Partnership Level.
