Outdoors + Nature



Explore amidst 110 acres of breathtaking beauty at Dow Gardens. Drenched in color, the gardens come alive each fall with autumnal shades

and unforgettable scenery — including bird's-eye views from four stories high along the nation's longest treetop canopy walk within Whiting Forest!

Take your fall experience to new heights (right through the colorful treetops) at Frankenmuth Aerial Park! Experience combination courses with ropes and ziplines, fly through the air, swing through trees, and challenge yourself at this aerial obstacle course.

Explore thousands of acres of unspoiled nature at Shiawassee National Wildlife Refuge. Whether you boat through the "Everglades of Michigan" with Johnny Panther Quests Adventure Trips, or cruise the 6.5-mile Wildlife Drive auto tour, experience wildlife encounters with spectacular species and marvel at Mother Nature's paintbrush.

Snuggle up under a cozy blanket and let the rhythmic clip-clop of horses' hooves lull you into relaxation with Fantasy Carriage Company or Frankenmuth Carriage Company. Ride in comfort through leaf-lined streets, take in the hues of fall, and gather tidbits of history and lore of Little Bavaria on your ride through Frankenmuth!

Bring your favorite adult beverage and up to 15 friends for a colorful ride through Frankenmuth with PedAle Trolley! Tour the fall colors in unique fashion on a City River Tour, and enjoy 3 - 5 stops at shops, pubs, and attractions. Too few riders for the whole trolley? Look to single seats on Thursday- or Saturday-night bar-hopping tours!

Sip a seasonal hard cider or brew on a pedalpowered mobile party with Sunrise Pedal Trolley! Gather 8 - 15 friends, and cruise through Downtown

Bay City, enjoying views of the riverfront alive with fall color! Tour picturesque historic districts, take in Uptown, and enjoy every drop of local flavor on your fall excursion.

Take a colorful trek through Chippewa Nature Center and discover one of the largest private, non-profit nature centers in the United States! With 19 miles of scenic trails, fall for seasonal splendor, autumnal workshops, and an Arboretum with more than 100 species of Michigan-native trees and shrubs.

Gaze at the sunset in serenity on the nearly mile-long shoreline at Bay City State Park — and take a gander at fall color from two observation towers in Tobico Marsh, one of the largest freshwater coastal wetlands in the Great Lakes. Choose the paved trail, or go where you like through acres of gorgeous fall colors!

See shades of autumn like never before amidst picturesque terraces and row-upon-row of bursting blooms at Dahlia Hill. Experience a kaleidoscope of seasonal color from more than 300 unique dahlia varieties across 3,000 plants!

With close to 100 miles of interwoven paths, find yourself immersed in stunning fall splendor along the Great Lakes Bay Regional Trail. Wander, hike, or rent bikes from multiple Ray's Bike Shop locations, and enjoy your time beneath the colorful canopy.

Look to the sky along 142 miles of Saginaw Bay Birding Trail for fall glory and glorious nature sightings! Home to 200+ species of birds, discover sprawling shoreline and natural areas that make this trail a birder's paradise.

Tee off amidst autumnal landscapes and gorgeous fall foliage at two of Michigan's must-play public golf courses, The Fortress and Apple Mountain, or discover more than a dozen other courses dotted throughout the region.

Lose yourself in corn or soybean mazes, but find your way back for live music on weekends, shopping, and cider & donuts!

There's more to Grandpa Tiny's Heritage Farm than meets the eve! From craft fairs to photo ops to picking the perfect pumpkin, you'll find your favorite fall memories are made here! Take a step back in time, meet the animals, have a hayride, and end the day with cider & donuts.

Located on the grounds of Weiss Centennial Farm, explore the five-acre Frankenmuth Corn Maze! With 2.5 miles of winding trails, three observation bridges, and more than 20 interactive game stations, you might get lost, but you'll enjoy it! Gather in an intimate space at Prost! Wine Bar & Charcuterie and discover six tap wines, served at the perfect temperature. Try the Tap Sampler or house specialties like Sapsucker, made with bourbon and Michigan maple syrup!


Oracle Brewing Company - Saginaw, MI





If leaf piles are for jumping in, puddles are for playing, and your people still get caramel apples all over their little faces — then this guide to fall family fun is for you!

With pumpkin patches & corn mazes ready — and fresh apple cider & donuts waiting at orchards & farms — read on to discover what to do this season when you Go Great Lakes Bay in Pure Michigan!

Outdoors + Nature

Rediscover the magic of childhood wonder at Dow Gardens! Kids of all ages will be inspired by 24 beautiful bronze sculptures in Gary Lee Price's Celebrate the Children exhibit, on display through September. Catch a bird's-eye view of brilliance, too, inside Whiting Forest — along a 1,400-foot canopy walk through the trees that stretches as high as 40 feet in the air!

The colorful treetops await your family this fall at Frankenmuth Aerial Park! Swing through the woods and challenge yourselves on an aerial obstacle course with ziplines! Enjoy hours of fall fun and one-of-a-kind memories with the kids.

Crunch leaves underfoot together at Chippewa Nature Center. Explore 19 miles of nature trails and hands-on exhibits at the Homestead Farm, Visitor Center, and Ecosystem Gallery. Be sure to climb the two-story observation tower that overlooks the wetlands!

Meet more than 150 animals, including African penguins and a two-toed sloth, at the Saginaw Children's Zoo! Situated on 10 acres of landscaped paths, pass through beautiful gardens and find peacock feathers before riding the hand-carved carousel and miniature train!

Explore 56 acres of Reptile Sanctuary, Rainforest Experience, and more at Wilderness Trails Zoo. Home to more than 200 animals and 50 different species, get hands-on in the petting area or have a close encounter with a parakeet!

Discover the changing season together along nearly a mile of Saginaw Bay shoreline at Bay City State Park. Walk through a nearby lagoon full of wildlife, birds, and even fish to catch, and climb two observation towers in the scenic Tobico Marsh for fall color and fun.
