



Hello and thank you for registering for the 2026 AAU Boys National Volleyball Championship in Orlando FL July 3rd-July 10!
As we approach important dates, here are some reminders:

IMPORTANT RULES

Athletes may only compete in ONE (1) Wave.

All teams must compete in their age division. Teams are NOT permitted to 'play up'.

REGISTRATION

The **LAST DAY** to register for AAU Boys Volleyball Nationals is **MAY 10th, 2026**.
Payment is due by MAY 10th to secure each team's spot.

ROSTER DEADLINE: JUNE 15th, 2026, AT 11:59 PM EST.
Late roster changes/additions may be subject to late roster fees.

WITHDRAWS

The LAST DAY to withdraw a team and receive a 50% refund is May 10th, 2026.
Any drop requests after May 10th, 2026, will result in **NO REFUND**.

Teams who intend to drop from AAU Volleyball Nationals must reach out to volleyball@aausports.org or dropvolleyball@aausports.org a minimum of 48 hours before the start of their wave.

LATE DROPS: If a team drops within the restricted 48-hour period, their club will forfeit the early registration discount for all of their teams attending Nationals the following year and must wait until January 15th to be accepted/register all their teams for the event.

TEAM CHECK IN

Team check-in will take place in **OCCC North Room 220**

Wave 1: July 2nd, 2026, 8AM-7PM
Wave 2: June 6th, 2026, 8AM-7PM

Teams must be checked in IN PERSON the Day prior to Competition. Failure to attend team check-in will result in the team being dropped from the National Championship, and late drop penalties mentioned above will apply.

Plan to ensure your Club Director or Coaches arrive to check-in prior to 6:30pm on the day before your wave begins.

Only Club Directors and Coaches will be allowed in the check-in room.

All final roster changes can be made during the check-in process. Once you leave check-in, further changes will be \$25 per change made at Championship Desks. NO players can be added after the team's first match.

OFFICIATING RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Every team must provide qualified persons for work assignments.
2. Responsibilities include two-line judges, score keeper, libero tracker, scoreboard operator and in some instances a rostered adult as a down referee.
3. Rostered adult(s) with non-athlete membership are responsible for the work of the table personnel and must be present at score table during teams assigned work time.
4. Please direct all questions to the championship desk.

SCHEDULING AND RULES

Schedule will be available one week before competition dates on www.advancedeventsystems.com and <http://www.aauvolleyball.org>

It is the coaches' responsibility to know if there will be a tiebreaker. Do not leave the playing site until the results are finalized.

If a team involved in a tie leaves, they will be eliminated from the Championship division.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Athletic trainers will be on site.

Concessions and a team cooler room will be available.

Coolers and outside food and drink are NOT ALLOWED in the playing facilities. Only water and sports drinks can be brought inside the facilities.

Outside chairs are not permitted, including personal, portable, or inflatable chairs.

Violation of these policies or any other general misbehavior may result in IMMEDIATE dismissal from the facility for the remainder of the day.
