AAU MEMBERSHIP: All athletes, coaches and officials must be current members of the AAU and be able to present their 2025

AAU membership card at check-in. AAU membership is \$20.00 per youth athlete, \$22.00 per adult athlete (19-older), and \$75.00 per coach (non-athlete 2-year membership, or \$55 per coach 1-year membership). The cost of membership is in addition to the entry fee. All athletes and coaches should have already purchased a membership

card prior to the qualifying tournament. To become a member, join online at www.aausports.org.

You can no longer register for non-athlete (coach) or adult athlete membership onsite. New this year, background screens are conducted for all non-athletes and adult athletes. Membership is no longer

instant. BE PREPARED and register your coaches early!

ENTRY FEE: \$80.00 per athlete and \$50.00 per coach. All fees are non-refundable. The entry fee is in addition to the AAU

membership card.

\$25.00 per athlete- Workshop Only! This is a great option for athletes new to the sport who are interested in learning

new skills and increasing their jump rope knowledge.

ANY ATHLETE ENTRIES NOT RECEIVED BY THE ABOVE-MENTIONED DEADLINE MAY NOT BE

ACCEPTED! LATE COACH ENTRIES WILL REQUIRE A \$10 LATE FEE.

Registration for the Jump Rope events is a two-part process:

<u>STEP #1:</u> ATHLETES and COACHES must register online at https://aausports.org/junior-olympic-games/ and pay the entry fee. Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express accepted. You will need your 2024 AAU membership number at the time of registering online. Once you have registered online, you will receive an email

confirming your entry and acceptance of payment.

<u>STEP #2:</u> COACHES must create a roster for the team and enter athletes into events by completing the **JUMP ROPE TEAM ENTRY FORMS**. These forms are available for downloading at https://aausports.org/junior-olympic-games/ under Jump Rope. Officials' information must also be submitted. Selected officials will be notified

approximately two weeks before the competition.

It is extremely important that all entries are submitted online no later than the above-mentioned deadline date. ENTRIES RECEIVED BEYOND THAT DATE MAY NOT BE ACCEPTED! Team entry forms must also be

received by the deadline in order for athletes to be entered in the events.

QUALIFICATION: Participation in the JUMP ROPE event requires an Athlete Nomination Application or qualifying by participation in a designated licensed AAU Jump Rope event or tournament. For more information on qualifying tournaments, contact

COACHES & OFFICIALS:

All coaches and officials must be registered members of the AAU. **Teams must nominate officials in a ratio of 1 official per 4 athletes.** All officials should be dressed in white shirts and navy pants, skirts or shorts and athletic shoes.

COACHES' EDUCATION:

The AAU is happy to make available **FREE Coaches' Education** for all AAU non-athlete members. This excellent program is **MANDATORY** for all AAU non-athletes and will be administered by Positive Coaching Alliance (PCA). Please visit https://aausports.org/positive-coaching-alliance/ and click on PCA COACHES EDUCATION order to enter and take the MANDATORY AAU/PCA coaches educational course. Membership may be revoked from non-athletes who do not complete course prior to competition.

COMPETITION FORMAT:

The Technical Committee reserves the right to eliminate, add or combine events in response to the number and distribution of entries.

Competition will consist of the following seven events: (1) Individual Single Rope Triple Crown Competition (Speed - Power - Freestyle). (2) Single Rope Pairs Triple Crown Competition (Speed - Power - Freestyle). (3) Double Dutch Single (3 person) Triple Crown (Speed - Power - Freestyle). (4) Double Dutch Pairs (4 person) Triple Crown (Speed - Power - Freestyle). (5) Group Routine. (6) 4-Person Single Rope Freestyle Routine. (7) One-Minute Triple Unders (15-older age groups only)

RULES:

EVENTS & AGE DIVISIONS:

Males Singles: 8 and under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-16, 17-18, 19-22, 23-older Females Singles: 8 and under, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15-16, 17-18, 19-22, 23-older Pairs: 8 and under, 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-17, 18-older (Pairs may be mixed gender) Double Dutch: 12 and under, 13-14, 15-17, 18-older (may be same or mixed gender) Group Routines: 14 and under, 15-older (Teams may be mixed gender)

4-Person Single Rope Freestyle: 14 and under, 15-older (Teams may be mixed gender)

One Minute Triple Unders: Males and Females 15-older

AGE DETERMINATION:

The competitor's age is determined by June 15 of the competition year. Whatever the age of the competitor on June 15, 2025 is competitor's official competition age for the 2025 competition year. Proof must be provided if challenged (certified birth certificate or comparable legal document).

AWARDS:

AAU Junior Olympic Games medals will be awarded to the top three (3) overall athletes in the combined events of the Triple Crown for Individual, Pairs, and Double Dutch in each division age group. A team plaque or banner will be awarded to the top three (3) teams in the Group Routine. Medals will be awarded to the first three place winners of the component events and ribbons will be awarded for 4th through 10th place. All participants will receive a T-shirt commemorating the event. The Technical Committee may change the awards given.

SOUND EQUIPMENT:

Sound equipment will be provided. Coaches may be required to submit their music online prior to the start of the competition; instructions will be provided accordingly. Each individual or team is responsible for providing the accompaniment to the Sound Manager on a standard MP3 player or submitted online in appropriate format as directed. MP3 players must have the song selected on a single play list. MP3 players should be clearly marked with the competitor's and team name. No volume adjustments will be made. The volume and quality of the accompaniment are the responsibility of the competitor and not the Sound Manager. Volume or quality of sound will not be judged. A back-up device with the team's music is encouraged.

CHECK-IN:

Jump Rope participants must check-in to receive their athlete credential or coach wristband. Check-in is located at the George R. Brown Convention Center. The appropriate credential or wristband will be needed prior to gaining admittance into the competition venues. Participants should check-in at least the day prior to competing. *If that credential or wristband is lost or stolen there will be a replacement fee*. For check-in hours, maps and additional directions please visit www.aaujrogames.org (click on Event Info, then Registration).

NOTE: In addition to checking in to receive your credential, Team Coaches MUST also check in at the Jump Rope sport table at the Greensboro Coliseum during the designated Coach Check-In time.

PARKING:
