LIMITED POWER OF ATTORNEY

The undersigned, Jonathan Bulkeley, hereby constitutes and appoints each of Mark J. Ohringer, Gordon G. Repp and Mary L. Wahlen, signing singly, as his true and lawful attorney-in-fact for the limited purposes of:

- (1) executing for and on behalf of the undersigned Forms 3, 4 and 5 in accordance with Section 16(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended (the "Exchange Act"), and the rules thereunder;
