His advocacy for learning extends far beyond the classroom, as he continues to encourage and uplift students of all ages to pursue excellence and self-discovery.

Prior to full-time ministry, Dr. Harrington built a successful career in banking and finance—experience that strengthened his commitment to economic empowerment and community development. His leadership roles with organizations such as Habitat for Humanity, Hope Credit Union's Advisory Council, and the City of Memphis Re-Entry Program (Manhood University) reflect a longstanding dedication to expanding opportunity for underserved populations. In 2019, his contributions were honored with the University of Arkansas Pine Bluff Memphis Alumni Chapter's Friend of Education Award.
