
## Retention

Measure: Fall-to-Fall Full-time First-time Freshman

Target: 75% by 2027

Threshold of Acceptability: 58%

Lane College's Strategic Plan sets the target for fall-to-fall full-time first-time Freshmen at 75% by 2027 and the threshold of acceptability at 58% based on pre-pandemic achievement rate.



# **Course Completion**

Measure: Gateway English and Math course success rate

Targets: 54% for English and 63% for Math

Thresholds of Acceptability: 37% for English and 49% for Math

Lane College sets the target based on the 3-year institutional average and the threshold of acceptability based on year-1 achievement rate of the New General Education Core implemented in Fall of 2021.

#### Graduation


Measure: 6-year Graduation Rate

Target: 35% by 2027

Threshold of Acceptability: 31%

Lane College sets the target for 6-year graduation rate at 35% and the threshold of acceptability at 31% based on the 3-year IPEDS comparison group average.

Target: 5-year institutional average

#### **Graduate/Professional School Placement**

Target: 19%

Threshold of Acceptability: 11%

Lane College sets the graduate/professional school placement target to approach 19% based on 5-year institutional average and the threshold of acceptability at 11% based on pre-pandemic placement rate.

For post-graduation employment, the threshold of acceptability is set at 84% based on 3-year institutional average while the target aims to exceed pre-pandemic rate at 90%.
