#### What neighborhoods are being considered for this project?

There will be specific criteria for a neighborhood or district to qualify for this program as well as an application process. In general, neighborhoods should include tourism-related infrastructure and not be an incorporated city within Jefferson County.

### What other cities have similar signage programs?

Many cities have similar programs. Some that would be good examples include: Oklahoma City, Cleveland, Columbus OH – specifically the Short North neighborhood.

#### Should we include design concepts in the proposal?

While not required, initial design concepts would be helpful in evaluating the breadth and capabilities of the bidding firm. It may also help move through the design phase more quickly with the chosen vendor. Consider one unified brand that incorporates a singular element related to each neighborhood as stated in the RFP.

## How many neighborhoods will receive signage?

This will be dependent primarily on cost but also neighborhood/district involvement. We estimate between 5-10 neighborhoods could receive some type of signage.

# Is there a budget for each phase? Design, Fabrication and Installation?
