DESCRIPTION

The North American International Livestock Exposition (NAILE) is the world's largest all-breed purebred livestock exposition, it features more than 140 competitions with nearly 30,000 entries in 10 divisions: beef cattle, boer goats, dairy cattle, dairy goats, draft horses, llamas and alpacas, market swine, mules and donkeys, and sheep. The Show has an estimated 200,000 visitors from 48 states and two dozen foreign countries. The shows audience ranges from young families to seniors.
