| 2    | 6              | Saint Vincent de Paul | Saint Vincent de Paul lived out Jesus' new commandment by caring for people who were sick and people who were poor.    |
|      | 7              | Removing the Thorn    | Saint Jerome is an example of someone who practiced the Beatitudes.  |
|      | 8              | The Ascension         | After the Resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven. From there he shares his new life with us through the Holy Spirit. |
|      | 9              | Meal                  | We can practice the works of mercy by following Saint Teresa of Calcutta's example.                                    |
|      | 10             | The Procession        | <i>Las Posadas</i> is one tradition that can help us prepare to celebrate Jesus' birth.                                |
| 3    | 11             | Saint Dominic         | Saint Dominic provides an example of how to follow Jesus.  |
|      | 12             | Holy Apostles         | After Judas Iscariot betrayed Jesus, the Apostles chose Matthias to be his replacement.                                |
|      | 13             | The Prodigal Son      | God's Son, Jesus, teaches us about God the Father's forgiveness through the parable of the forgiving father.           |
|      | 14             | The Virgin            | We are all children of Mary, the Mother of Church.   |
|      | 15             | Adoration of the Magi | The feast days that are part of the Christmas season help us joyfully celebrate Jesus' birth.                          |
| 4    | 16             | The Good Shepherd     | Jesus teaches us about his love and care for us through the parable of the lost sheep.                                 |
|      | 17             | Feeding Five Thousand | The story of Jesus feeding the 5,000 is an example of his compassion for his disciples.                                |
|      | 18             | Saint James           | We, like the members of the early Church, carry on Jesus' healing work by caring for people who are sick or suffering. |
|      | 19             | Grape Pickers         | When we grow in our relationship with Jesus, we become like productive branches that grow much fruit.                  |
|      | 20             | Jesus Mosaic          | The season of Lent ends with the celebration of the Triduum during Holy Week.  |
| 5    | 21             | The Ten Commandments  | God gave the Hebrews the Ten Commandments to help them remain faithful to the covenant he made with them.              |
|      | 22             | The American Church   | The first three commandments teach us to love God above all.   |
|      | 23             | Love Your Enemies     | Jesus calls us to forgive, love, and pray for our enemies.   |
|      | 24             | The Promised Land     | God wrote the message of the covenant on the hearts of the Hebrews.  |
|      | 25             | Easter Morning        | During the Easter season, we celebrate the new life we receive through Christ's Resurrection.                          |
