1	1	The Flower Seller	God creates the world and all things in it, and we show our love for God by protecting his creation.
	2	Saint Peter Claver	Saint Peter Claver is an example of living God's Word because he helped those who were oppressed and enslaved find salvation in God.
	3	Moses and the Tablets	God gave Moses the Ten Commandments to help us live peaceful and loving lives.
	4	Saint Philip Neri	We can serve God's kingdom with our talents and gifts.
	5	Centering	Ordinary Time is a time to celebrate our connection to God through the sacraments.
2	6	The Corner Stone	We are the building blocks on which the Church is built, and Jesus is the capstone.
	7	Jairus's Daughter	We are reminded of Jesus' presence through the celebration of the sacraments.
	8	Peter Preaching	Through the Sacraments of Initiation, we can enter into life in Christ.
	9	The Spirit Descends	The Holy Spirit helps us act as witnesses to Jesus' mission and strengthens our relationship with God.
	10	Walking to Church	Advent is a time to experience the sacraments and prepare for Jesus.
3	11	Psalm 100	The Church is both unified and diverse because of God's grace.
	12	Extraordinary Synod	Like apostles, church leaders are chosen to be witnesses to Jesus Christ and carry on his work.
	13	Jesus Among Doctors	Jesus calls all of us to fulfill our roles within our families and respect our mothers and fathers.
	14	Joseph, the Carpenter	Jesus calls everyone to use his or her talents to serve God and others.
	15	Nativity	The Christmas season reminds us of the way we are called to live holy lives.
4	16	Jesus Feeds the Crowd	Jesus gave us the Eucharist so that we can have everlasting life with him.
	17	Last Supper	In the Eucharist, we thank Jesus for his sacrifice.
	18	Risen Christ	In the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation, we celebrate God's forgiveness, receive absolution for our sins, and are reconciled with ourselves, God, and the Church.
	19	Peter and John Heal	In the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, we celebrate Jesus' healing power.
	20	Good Friday	Lent is a time to remember the Passion of Jesus and forgive others as we would like to be forgiven.
5	21	Saint Francis	Caring for others is a foundation of a moral life.
	22	The Connemara Gossips	Jesus wants us to be mindful of and respectful toward others in our words and actions.
	23	Kateri Tekakwitha	It takes courage to live one's life according to Jesus' message.
	24	The Last Judgment	Living as faith-filled followers of Jesus means living with our Father in heaven.
	25	Pentecost	Easter is a time to reflect on the mission we are being given by Jesus.
