| | REMEMBER In the Gospel of John, Jesus' miracles are referred to as signs that reveal who Jesus is and who the Father is. Jesus' first miracle took place at a wedding feast in Cana. |

| | DEFINE sacrament, rite, penance, repentance |
| | REMEMBER Sacraments are sacred rites that are signs of God's love and presence in our lives. The seven sacraments were given to us by Jesus so that God's life and love can fill our lives. |
