



Jesus and Me

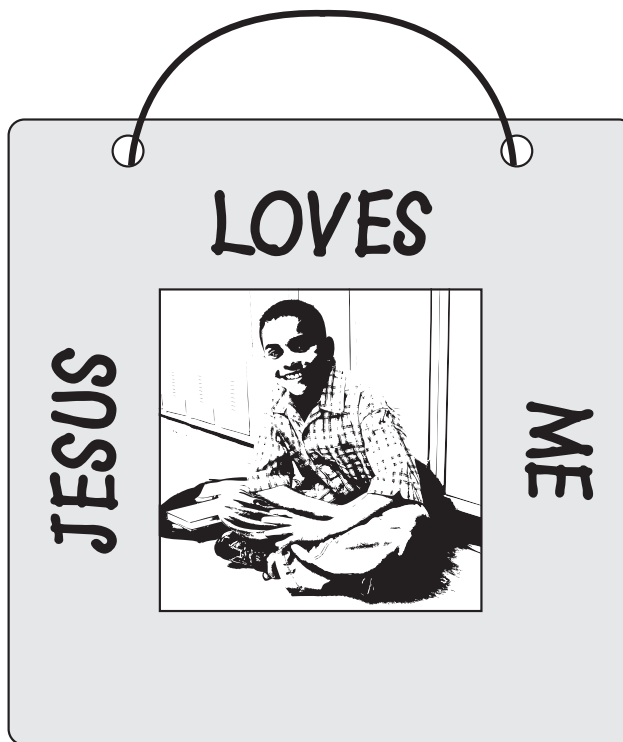
Grades 1–4

Materials:

One square (6½" × 6½") of poster board per student	One small square photograph of each student (approximately 1½")
Felt-tip markers	White glue
Yarn or string	Paper punch

FAITH CONNECTION

The apostles were chosen by Jesus to be his friends and to witness to others. God chooses each Christian to do the same in today's world. In this activity, students will make a special plaque to hang in their rooms to remind them that Jesus loves them. Just as our photograph reflects what we look like, Jesus calls us to reflect his love to others.



Before Class:

Pencil in the letters of the words *Jesus Loves Me* (1" block printing) around the edges of the poster board. (See drawing for placement of words.) You may wish to prepunch two holes near the top and add the yarn or string for hanging before giving the poster board pieces to the students.

Directions:

1. Have the students trace over the letters with felt-tip pens.
2. Glue the photograph in the center. Let dry.
3. Punch two holes near the top of the picture and loop a piece of yarn or string for hanging the picture.
