CHEMNITZ'S WORKS

Often referred to as “the second Martin,” Martin Chemnitz is credited with solidifying and defining the Reformation movement begun by Martin Luther. He was a major contributor to the Formula of Concord and is considered one of the greatest Lutheran theologians of all time.

His works have created a basis of dialogue between Catholics and Lutherans while adding valuable insight into topics including the Council of Trent, the Lord’s Supper, the Lord’s Prayer, the two natures of Christ, the Trinity, and creation.
