

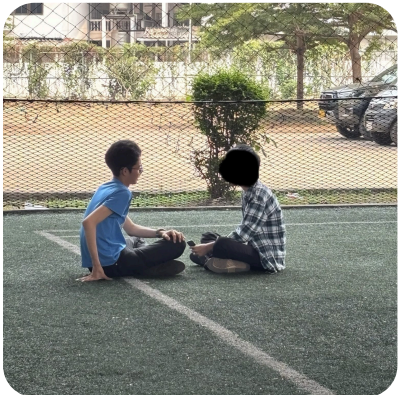


Twin Shores



This April, we sent a mission trip of 14 students to a nearby country we will call "Twin Shores." Twin Shores remains one of the least-reached countries in Southeast Asia, where many people have never heard a clear explanation of the gospel. Ministry there often happens quietly through relationships, presence, and faithfulness rather than public programs. The Church there has grown through perseverance under pressure, with believers continuing to follow Jesus amid restrictions. Students and young adults play a key role in this story, exploring faith courageously in challenging environments where the gospel is still taking root.

Sun Shining the Light of Christ



One of our students from the south, Sun, (pictured above) joined the trip. He became a Christian less than a year ago, and has grown so much in his faith!

“This mission was tough due to the heat and the need for caution, but God taught us to trust Him and use our gifts. Seeing Him work miracles on Sports Day gave me a fresh vision for Thailand: to rely more on the Holy Spirit and serve wholeheartedly. God doesn't need perfection; He just needs a willing heart. I'm coming back with a burden to share the Gospel like never before.”

Fruit from the Mission



In just one week, the team experienced what it means to depend on Jesus daily and saw His provision in powerful ways. Despite limited access on campuses and challenging conditions, God opened doors for meaningful conversations.

The team engaged students both on campus and through relational activities like sports outreach and small group conversations. Through these efforts, they were able to share the gospel with over 120 students, and we rejoice that 33 students made decisions to follow Christ. These numbers go beyond what the team initially hoped for and reflect God's work in drawing people to Himself.

Just as important as what God did through the team is what He did in them. This trip was designed to help our students grow in their vision for cross-cultural ministry, and we are already seeing that take shape. Many returned with a deeper dependence on God, a growing heart for the nations, and a clearer

sense that their lives can be used for God's kingdom purposes beyond Thailand.

The team also had the opportunity to serve alongside local believers, encouraging and strengthening those who are faithfully ministering in a more restricted environment. While follow-up is still ongoing, we're thankful that connections have been made and initial steps are being taken to continue walking with those who expressed interest.

US Students Coming!

Just like Sun and other university students in our ministry went to Twin Shores for a missions trip, we have our annual US group of university students coming to share the Gospel here in Hatyai next month. Please pray that God would start preparing each one of their hearts and raise the financial support they need to join the trip.

Another fun additional note is that I will be taking about 2 weeks of vacation in June as my little brother, Josh, and his wife, Ashlyn, will be coming to visit me. I'm excited and anxious for their arrival. It's such a rare treat to have loved ones make the long trek over to Thailand to visit. It's a gift to not only see them but to share what our life looks like with them.
