"The first time I talked to him it was on July 2nd. I met him 5 minutes after a not so successful gospel introduction with another student. We introduced ourselves and sat down and I started to get to know him with basic conversation about his major, where he is from, and what he likes to do. We got to a point in the conversation that we started talking about how the universe was created and he said that he believed that there is a creator, but the creator just made the universe as an experiment. From there I started to tell him that I also believe in a creator, but the creator (God) made us with love and purpose. After that I introduced him to almost everything about the gospel and concepts such as God, his love, mercy, grace, Jesus, the Bible and many other concepts. At the end of our conversation I asked him if he believed that all of this is true and he said yes, but he said that he wanted to believe Christianity *and* Buddhism at the same time, but I left that topic for a follow up.

The second time we met, I went through the Knowing God Personally [gospel tract] with him and answered a few questions he had throughout the conversation. At the end I asked him if he was willing to accept Jesus and pray the prayer, and he said yes! After that I asked some questions to him to see if

he understood the gospel and how salvation works and he did understand everything. I was surprised! After that I invited him to church and he ended up attending Hay Yai city church. Days later I invited him for dinner with me and Keith [Jaz's teammate] to introduce them both, and at the end of the dinner I gave Sanya a Bible and shared his contact with Keith so they can arrange Bible studies. I am excited to see him grow in his journey with God!"



To get to see a student like Sanya accept Christ is so very rewarding. I'm so glad David got to experience God's love in this way. What excites me all the more is that Sanya's girlfriend, Eng, is actually a dear friend of mine who I got to know through her attending my weekly English Corner last year.
