A few weeks after I graduated from high school, I had the opportunity to go on a mission trip to New York City with Fellowship Greenville. I still remember getting food poisoning from a questionable burger—and I remember playing a few games of street basketball with some local guys, which opened the door to share the Gospel with them afterward.

Since then, I've been part of mission efforts in places all over the world. And I can honestly say—few things have shaped my journey as a disciple-maker more than witnessing God at work in different cultures and communities in other parts of the world.

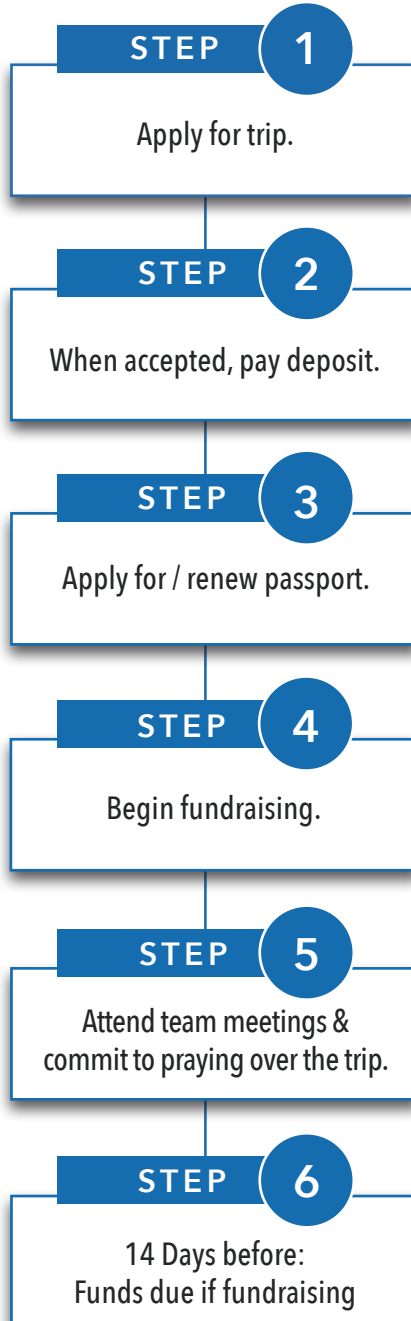

Partner: Back2Back Ministries

A team of adults and families will be partnering with Back2Back Ministries to support orphan care initiatives and participate in light construction projects that improve living conditions for vulnerable children.

DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

Partner: Manna Global Missions

Partner: Josiah Venture

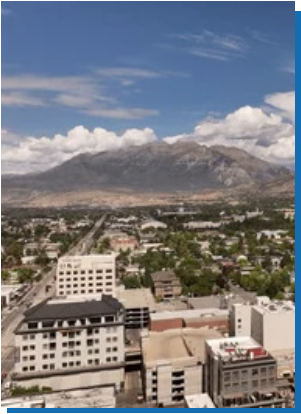
