4. What from the book of Acts most impacted you and why?


2. ASSESS + APPLY

3. Why is waiting on the Lord so difficult for us? What does the waiting bring out of you?
4. What are you currently waiting on?
 - a. Pray for one another in regard to these things.
 - b. Waiting on God by Andrew Murray is an excellent devotional book that will help you in your waiting.
 - c. We would also recommend Waiting Isn’t a Waste by Mark Vroegop.
5. Devoted means to be “busily engaged with.” What would it look like for us as a discipleship group to be more devoted together to prayer?
6. Who resonated with the vision Brock casted about our church becoming more so a praying church. A church devoted to fervent prayer. Why does this resonate with you?
7. Who specifically in your life is mourning who needs your prayer? Take time as a group to intercede on behalf of these folks.
8. First Tuesday is this Tuesday at 5:30 PM. Let’s seek to prioritize this.
9. Who here would be willing to host a prayer gathering at your place sometime soon?
