WORSHIP & WALK


1. REVIEW + UNDERSTAND

1. Seek to begin your time with worship.
2. Read Luke 1:57-80.
3. Is anyone planning to carve out time this week to watch a sunrise? What theological truths can a sunrise communicate to our hearts?
4. How is joy tied to God's faithfulness? Why is this such good news?

2. ASSESS + APPLY

1. What promise of God do you need to be reminded of? Encourage one another with promises God has made to us.
2. Love always draws near. Where have you most tangibly experienced the nearness of God recently?
3. What in the gospel of Luke has most ministered to your heart thus far?
4. God communicates His redemptive power and to us in many ways - through His Word, through salvation stories, through creation even. We see it in the promises he makes. We also see God's redemptive power in the ways He helps us overcome sin struggles. Are there ways you have seen God's redemptive power at work in your life recently? Any ways He has helped you overcome temptation lately?
5. In your breakout time, discuss ways you may hold each other accountable throughout the month of February.
