1. REVIEW + UNDERSTAND

2. Read Luke 3:18-20 and pray together.
3. What is a key takeaway from this text?

2. ASSESS + APPLY

1. Has anyone ever confronted you in a godly way? Did you grow through it as a result?
2. Who has set a good example for you of confronting evil in a godly way?
3. Which of the “seven questions we are to ask before we confront someone” has most hit home with you? And why? (If you need to see this slide go to the church center app, go to sermons, click the sermon from Sunday, then click sermon slides)
4. Confronting evil in a godly way comes at a worthy cost. Why is it worthy?
5. What is the prosperity gospel? How does John the Baptist’s life show the prosperity gospel is actually anti-gospel?
6. In breakout time:
 - a. What is a cost you need to be willing to pay this week as you full-heartedly following Jesus?
 - b. What evil in your own life do you need to have a confrontation with? We need the Word of God to help us in this. Have a volunteer read 1 Timothy 3:16-17 below.
