## WORSHIP & WALK

### 1. REVIEW + UNDERSTAND

1. Seek to begin your time with worship.
2. Pray over your time and read 1 Cor. 15:1-28.
3. What is a key takeaway from this text?
4. Why do christians who are already saved need the gospel?

### 2. ASSESS + APPLY

1. What are ways in our daily lives we can hold fast to the gospel?
2. Happy Easter, you're a bad savior. Haha! You are not the primary actor in your salvation. God is! In this season of your life, is this something you are worshiping God over? Or has some of the awe of your salvation been lost over time?
3. When our awe of God wanes, what do we do? How do we respond?
4. When our awe of God is intense, what do we do with it? Consider ways you can encourage others within your discipleship group who might be struggling.
