

# SERMON APPLICATION GUIDE

The Son of God | Luke 3:21-38

## WORSHIP & WALK

### 1. REVIEW + UNDERSTAND

1. Seek to begin your time with worship.
2. Pray over your time and read Luke 3:21-22.
3. What in these two verses can give us deeper spiritual rest?
4. Why is it absolutely crucial for us as Christians that Jesus is truly the Son of God?

### 2. ASSESS + APPLY

- 1.2 Samuel 7:14 and Isaiah 11:10 reveal promises of God - that one from David's line will reign on the throne forever. Because Jesus conquered the grave and ascended to the heavenly places where He reigns forever, He is the fulfillment of these promises. The Son of God reigns! Many centuries passed between the time these promises were initially given to David & Isaiah, and the moment Jesus ascended. But God was faithful. If God has always been faithful to keep His promises throughout history, can't we trust He will be faithful to us today, and tomorrow? Where might you be struggling to remember this in your day to day life? Where might you be unintentionally doubting God's faithfulness?
2. One way we declare God's faithfulness is by being baptized before the church. Is this a step the Lord might be calling you to take? This is a next step for those who have not yet been baptized after placing faith in Jesus Christ.
3. One of the questions people are asked at their baptism is this - how has your life changed since following Jesus. Tonight, how would you say your life has changed since following the Son of God?

5. How could the things we've talked about tonight change this next week for you?
