Following Him | Luke 5:1-11

WORSHIP & WALK

1. REVIEW + UNDERSTAND

1. Seek to begin your time with worship.
2. Pray over your time and read Luke 5:1-11.
3. Look back at verse 8. What is Peter implying about Jesus?

2. ASSESS + APPLY

1. Read Luke 5:5. Simon was the captain of the boat, but a new captain was needed. Where in your life are you operating as “captain”? Where in your life do you need to step into greater surrender to *the* Captain?
2. What will happen if we (believers) don’t surrender in these specific areas?
3. Based on the way you are living day to day, are you viewing the commission to make disciples as more of a really good suggestion, or more as the authoritative and loving command over your life?
4. God’s power (verses 4-7) is overwhelming. Where have you seen God’s power in your life? Where do you desire to witness more of His power?
5. How does this passage inform the way we think about the 4WLife? (Worship, Walk, Work & Witness)
6. Why is it worth leaving everything to follow Jesus? Spend time in worship together just finishing this sentence over and over. Jesus is worthy because _____. (Fill in the blank)
7. Which of these 5 encouragements do you most need reminded of and why? How are you going to remind yourself of this?
 - a. Following Christ is for normal, broken, everyday people.
 - b. Following Christ is THE turning point of your life.
 - c. Following Christ means joining Him on His mission.
 - d. Following Christ means leaving everything behind.
 - e. Following Christ means trusting Who we follow even when we don’t know where we’re going.
