Restoration by Christ's Power | Luke 5:12-26

WORSHIP & WALK

1. REVIEW + UNDERSTAND

1. Seek to begin your time with worship.
2. Pray over your time and read Luke 5:12-26.
3. Skim over Leviticus 13 and 14. Now Read Luke 5:12-14. What does this contrast reveal about Jesus?

2. ASSESS + APPLY

1. Why is it that physical healing is just a shadow (or an appetizer) of the ultimate restoration we find in Ephesians 2:1-10? What can we learn about this greater restoration from the lesser ones?
2. As you reflect on the miracle of your salvation, are you still filled with awe and amazement?
3. What stokes our awe and amazement of what God has done? What are ways we can do these things together as a group?
4. Does your faith in Jesus compel you to go to extraordinary measures to bring others to Him for restoration?
5. Where in your life is sin creating separation that needs Jesus' forgiveness and restoration?
6. What else in your life needs restoration currently? Please take time to pray for one another asking God to bring restoration.
7. Is anyone struggling with a physical ailment? If you haven't yet, please pray and ask for God's healing. Seek to pray in faith while also surrendered to whatever God wants to do (whether He will heal now, heal a little later one, or heal in glory).
