WORSHIP & WALK

1. REVIEW + UNDERSTAND

1. Seek to begin your time with worship.
2. Pray over your time and read Luke 5:33-39.
3. What is the purpose of fasting? Why does this discipline not fit the occasion of Jesus' ministry?
4. How do we become righteous in God's sight?

2. ASSESS + APPLY

1. What can we learn about what glory will be like with Jesus from this passage?
2. Why do people try to invent ways to make themselves right with God? In what ways do you find yourself thinking of yourself as more or less right with God based on your "earning"?
3. Why do religious routines for their own sake steal us from the joy of living in Christ's freedom? What routines do you find yourself prone to?
4. What would it look like for you to live in such a way that you are feasting at the banquet table of Christ? In other words, what are ways we can choose joy in the Lord this side of glory?
5. How will you lean into these things this Summer?
