WORSHIP & WALK

1. REVIEW + UNDERSTAND

1. Seek to begin your time with worship.
2. Pray and read Nehemiah 2 together.
3. What is the connection between Proverbs 16:9, 21:1, and Nehemiah 2?
4. Without looking at your notes (as a group) name as many ways as you can of God at work behind the scenes in Nehemiah 2.

2. ASSESS + APPLY

1. What does it look like to plan well while also resting in the sovereignty of God well? What are times you have struggled with this? What about times you have done this well? Boast in the Lord.
2. What are you currently planning in your life? How does this passage impact the way you plan?
 - a. Spend time in prayer for one another with your plans. Pray that God would establish steps.
3. How does this passage impact the way you work at your job (whether you are an employee, boss, student, stay at home parent etc.)
4. Nehemiah sets a good example by being obedient to the Lord though it's far from easy. What are ways you see one another choosing obedience though it is difficult? Take time to encourage one another.
5. Does anyone have any disobedience (including delayed obedience) you need to confess?
 - a. Pray for one another.
6. Just like Mark shared some stories of God's faithfulness to our church, share some stories of ways you have seen God's faithfulness in your lives.
