Justice & Sacrifice | Nehemiah 5

WORSHIP & WALK

1. REVIEW + UNDERSTAND

1. Seek to begin your time with worship.
2. Pray and read Nehemiah 5 together.
3. Take 2 minutes for everyone to summarize all of chapter 5 in one sentence. Have a few people read their sentence.

2. ASSESS + APPLY

1. God is just. What does this mean? Describe the justice of God as though you were explaining it to a young believer.
2. How does the Gospel impact the way we think about justice?
3. What are ways we can combat the desensitizing impact media can have on us as we are bombarded with terrible news on a regular basis from all across the globe. How do we combat the paralysis that can come with that?
4. What are ways we are able to pursue justice on others' behalf (without trying to take on vengeance which belongs to God alone)?
5. What is one specific area of injustice in our world today the Spirit tends to prick your heart about (abortion, sex trafficking, the killing of Christians around the globe, starving people without proper food/water, etc.)
 - a. What is one specific way you might provide greater support to that group being oppressed?
6. Spend time as a group praying for the marginalized.
7. Spend time praying together for a greater fear of God that will result in more worshipful sacrifice for others who are suffering.
8. Conclude your time of prayer praising God for His justice that will be carried out perfectly in the end.
