### **WORSHIP & WALK**

#### 1. REVIEW + UNDERSTAND

- 3. When opposition persists, we must persist. What are passages you cling to, or rhythms you have, that help you persist when the going gets tough?
- 4. What about when temptation hits? What are practical ways we can rely on God's help to overcome temptation?
- 5. If a spiritual leader like Nehemiah knocked on your door and gave you an inspiring speech tailored to you and your family, what do you think he would charge you with?
- 6. Who is someone in your life you need to be persistent with when it comes to showing them Christ and telling them about Him?
- 7. Nehemiah depends on God in prayer to stay focused and to combat the deceitful opposition coming at him. What are some ways as a group we can grow at depending on God in prayer together?
- 8. What do you think is most hindering your prayer life right now? How can we encourage one another with God's Word in this area?
- 9. If you feared God fully all the time, what are the other fears in your life that would come crumbling down? Pray together for one another that this would be the case.
