WORSHIP & WALK

1. REVIEW + UNDERSTAND

- 1. Seek to begin your time with worship. Perhaps you can do this by taking time as a group to recount God's faithfulness throughout our lives.
- 2. Pray and read Nehemiah 9-10 together.
- 3. Make a list together of God's attributes we learn from these chapters. Take a few minutes to pray together and simply praise God for being who He is.

2. ASSESS + APPLY

- 1. How would you explain to a new believer what it means to exalt God? What are practical ways we do this?
- 2. The greatest goal of confession and repentance is to exalt God. How do the Israelites in Nehemiah 9-10 model this for us? What are ways we can grow at exalting God in our confession and repentance?
- 3. In prayer have you ever recounted God's faithfulness throughout redemptive history? It is so powerful to not only thank Him for His faithfulness in our lives, but to thank Him for His faithfulness throughout all generations. *Remember and Rehearse* by J.T. English is a book that could help you learn to do this better. You can also prayerfully read through Nehemiah 9 and use it as a template.
- 4. In verse 31 we read God is a gracious and merciful God. Where in your life have you most recently been reminded of God's grace and mercy toward you?
- 5. Why is it important to contrast in tangible ways God's faithfulness versus our lack of faithfulness?
- 6. Are you more prone to get stuck in shame cycle, forgetting who God is the midst of your confession? Or, are you more likely to only zero in on God's grace and in doing so unintionally attempt to take advantage of Hig grace as you neglect to address your sin?
- 7. Confession and repentance walk hand in hand. If we aren't really repenting, what does that tell us about our confession? Why must these go hand in hand?
- 8. in break out time, discuss in more detail what you are turning from and what specifically you are turning to. Is God calling anyone here to spend more time journaling out a prayer of what you are turning from and what you are turning to?
