Bahrain

- February 28 – 45 Missiles, 9 Drones.¹
- March 1 - 16 Missiles, 25 Drones.²
- March 2 – 9 Missiles, 42 Drones.³
- March 3 – 3 Missiles, 15 Drones.⁴

Qatar

- February 28 – 65 Missiles, 12 Drones.⁵
- March 1 – 29 Missiles, 10 Drones.⁶
- March 2 – 9 Missiles,⁷ 7 Drones.⁸
- March 3 – 2 Missiles, 0 Drones.⁹

United Arab Emirates

- February 28 – 137 Missiles, 209 Drones.¹⁰
- March 1 – 30 Missiles, 332 Drones.¹¹
- March 2 – 15 Missiles, 148 Drones.¹²
- March 3 – 12 Missiles, 123 Drones.¹³

Kuwait

- The first 40 hours – 97 Missiles, 283 Drones.¹⁴
- Spans February 28-March 1 (at 3:30 PM Kuwait time)
- The next ~40 – 81 Missiles, 101 Drones.¹⁵

- Spans 38.5 hours: March 1 (at 3:31 PM Kuwait time)- March 3 (at 3:28 AM Kuwait time)
- These were the only sets of figures available as of the time of writing.

Jordan

- February 28 – 13 Missiles, 49 Drones.¹⁶
- March 3 – 1 Missile.¹⁷
- No further figures have been reported as of the time of writing.

Saudi Arabia

- February 28 – 2 Missiles,¹⁸ 0 Drones.
- March 1 – 4 Missiles, 2 Drones.¹⁹
- March 2 – 7 Drones.²⁰
- March 3 – 10 Drones.²¹

Syria

- February 28 – 1 Missile.²²
- March 2 – 1 Missile.²³
- March 3 – 2 Drones.²⁴

Cyprus

- March 2 – 3 Drones.²⁵



Iraq

- February 28-March 3 – Over 70 Missiles and Drones.²⁶

Oman

- March 1 – 3 Drones.²⁷
- March 2 – 1 Drone.²⁸
- March 3 – 5 Drones.²⁹

Israel

- February 28 – 90 Missiles,³⁰ “more than a dozen” Drones [estimated as 18].³¹

- March 1 – 60 Missiles,³² no update available on Drones.
- March 2 – 20 Missiles,³³ “dozens of” Drones TOTAL since February 28th [estimated as 42 for this day].³⁴
- March 3 – 20 Missiles,³⁵ “more than 100” Drones TOTAL since February 28th [estimated as 60 for this day].³⁶

- March 1: 139 Missiles, 372 Drones
- March 2: 54 Missiles, 250 Drones
- March 3: 38 Drones, 215 Drones
