Supplies Needed by Lesson

General Requirements

- Longarm or midarm quilting machine that is in good working order
- Ability to stand and quilt
- Muslin/Fabric
- Batting
- Thread
- Dry-erase board and dry-erase markers, sketch pad, tablet with drawing software (such as Procreate), or any tool for drawing and practicing designs
- Fabric scissors and small thread scissors
- Pins, zippers, snappers, or other frame attachment method
- Ruler base for your longarm and one straight-edge longarm ruler
- Large eye needles
- Fabric marking tools, such as water-soluble markers or chalk
- Two continuous, edge-to-edge pantograph designs
 - › Paper for anyone quilting from the back of their machine, following a light to a pre-printed paper design.
 - › For those using a computerized system, a core knowledge on executing and placing digital computerized designs using your system is required.
- Digital camera/phone (Certification Candidates)

**Some assignments will require you to complete an actual pieced quilt. The individual fabric requirements are included on the following page as well as in each individual lesson.*

Lesson 1

- 1 ½ yards of muslin (45" wide)
- Batting swatches (approximately 18" x 18") of each of the following:
 - › 100% cotton batting
 - › Blended batting (cotton/poly)
 - › Polyester batting
- Large eye needle
- Thread (your choice)

Lesson 2

- 9 yards muslin (45" wide)
- Batting
- Thread
- Digital camera/phone
- Permanent marking pen

Lesson 3

- Two pieces 45" wide muslin, each 1½ yards long
- Ruler or measuring tape
- Three DIFFERENT batting types, with each piece about 14" wide by 30" long
- One 8" block design of your choice, medium density
- Fabric marking pen
- Permanent marker
- Thread (your choice)

Lesson 4

- Two paper or computerized pantograph designs
- Two quilt tops (or panels), batting, backing, and binding
- Thread
- Digital camera/phone

Lesson 5

- Two 36" x 36" quilt tops or fabric panels
- Backing for both tops, at least 44" x 44" to safely load onto your longarm canvas rollers.
- Two 40" squares of batting
- Thread (your choice)
- Binding fabric
- Dry-erase board and markers (or similar) for practice

Lesson 6

- 2/3-yard light fabric for 9-patch blocks and setting blocks
- 1/3-yard dark fabric for 9-patch blocks
- 1/4-yard medium fabric for inner border
- 1/2-yard outer border fabric
- 1/3-yard fabric for binding
- Batting 42" x 42"
- 1½ yards muslin (45" wide)
- Thread (your choice)

Lesson 7

- Baby quilt completed in Lesson 6
- Batting (42" x 42") type of your choice
- Backing fabric (44" x 44")
- Thread (your choice)
- Ruler base and ruler for your longarm
- Marking tools (if desired)
- Block design (your choice)

Lesson 8

- Dry-erase board and markers (or similar)

Lesson 9

- 2½ yards muslin
- 44" x 44" square of batting with loft
- Thread (50 weight or finer recommended)
- Dry-erase board and markers (or similar) for practice
- Fabric marking tool
