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60 Degree Holiday Runner

Whether you are using scraps, fat quarters or larger pieces this runner is quick and fun! It's a great canvas for Pro-Stitcher Design

It is even faster if you use solid fabrics for the diamonds.

Sew many choices, Sew little Time!



Supplies:

Sewing machine with basic sewing thread for piecing

60-degree Diamond or Triangle Ruler

Fabric:

White 1 strip cut 1 ½"

Blue 1 strip cut 3"

Red 1 Strip 4"

¼ yard White Borders and ¼ diamond corners

Construction:

1. Stitch white strip between your red and blue.





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2. Press seams away from the white fabric.
3. Cut 2 – 60-degree triangles from each strip set yielding 1 diamond block!
 - a. Sample was made with 3 diamond block – 2 sets each color way.
 - b. 7 ½” tall X 9” wide
4. Repeat with all strip sets creating 14 triangles.
5. Layout your triangles with the background triangles.



6. Stitch triangles together creating 2 rows as seen above.
7. The rows will be opposite when stitched together. Best practice is to lay it out and stitch together.
8. You will press each triangle seam open.
9. Repeat for the second side.
10. Lay right sides together down the center as seen below.
11. Add 2 ½” borders to each side.
12. Load on your quilt frame and turn the Pro-Stitcher on and play.





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
